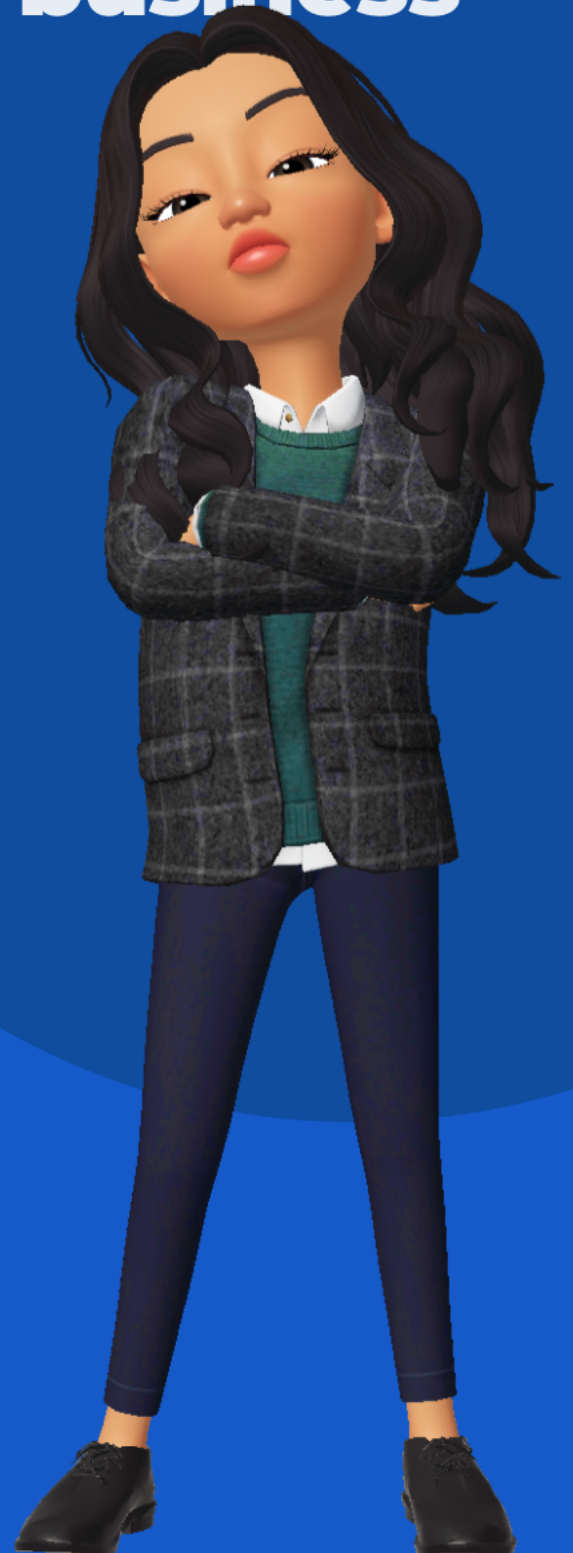

vocational subject

World integration processes

6 ECTS

216 academic hours

The discipline starts on the 2 year of study

The discipline is aimed at studying the concept, classification of international organizations, as well as the goals and activities of the key ones, the integration as one of the main trends of modern world development, structures, goals and activities of the main integration associations

You will study

- Major trends in world development: globalization and integration
- Functions of international organizations in the international arena
- International cooperation at the global level: history, modern trends and challenges and how to overcome them
- Basic forms of international cooperation at the regional and interregional levels.
- Russia in integration processes in the post-Soviet space: contemporary CIS
- International non-governmental organizations in international relations: how they changed today

After this course you will

- know the trends in the development of world political processes
- critically assess the activities of various actors in international relations, in particular, international organizations.
- be able to identify the prerequisites for the development of integration processes, analyze their goals and objectives
- be able to identify the factors of development of various global processes and the system of international relations, including in the context of the influence of international organizations

vocational subject

International conflicts

The discipline starts on the 4 year of study

The primary purpose of this course is to examine the conditions that make for war and peace in world politics, as well as the range of possible solutions that might help to prevent this problem in the future

2 ECTS

72 academic hours

You will study

- Factors and conditions that influence how wars can be terminated through conflict resolution processes, Different theoretical perspectives on conflict resolution.
- Why and under what conditions the parties in armed conflict can move from violent interactions to durable peace
- How different phases in conflict resolution processes interact with each other and between different levels of analysis
- How to structure and classify conditions and problems on different levels of analysis and in different stages of the conflict resolution process
- What role third parties and civil society can play in conflict resolution processes

After this course you will

- have the skills to search for nonstandard interpretations of international information and conduct appropriate analysis to solve the problems of professional activity
- be able to apply knowledge of a basis of regulation of the international conflicts with the use of diplomatic, politico-psychological, social and economic and power methods
- be able to independently analyze cases using central theories and concepts within the field of peace and conflict research
- know how to compare conditions and problems in peace processes within and between countries in their regional and international context

vocational subject

Conduct of Negotiations

The discipline starts on the 4 year of study

2 ECTS

72 academic hours

The objective of the discipline is to give students an idea of the theoretical and applied aspects of conducting international negotiations as well as of the current trends in international and Russian studies concerning international negotiations

You will study

- Various aspects of negotiations and the evolution of negotiation practices. The most important characteristics of negotiations
- Evolution of international negotiations studies. The works of F. De Calier, G. Nicholson, J. Nerges and others.
- Verbal and non-verbal communication in international negotiations
- Creating conditions for conducting negotiations under conflict and crisis. Factors influencing decision-making in a crisis
- The concepts of "diplomacy", "foreign policy" of the state.
- Negotiations at the high and highest level. Multilateral and multilevel negotiations

After this course you will

- know the rules and practices of a politically correct corporate culture of international communication (formal and informal), the skills of finding compromises through negotiations
- be able to apply the rules and practices of settling international conflicts by using diplomatic political and psychological, socioeconomic methods

4 vocational subject **International law**

4 ECTS

144 academic hours

The discipline starts on the 4 year of study

The main aim of the International law course is make students able to analyze national and international approaches to the regulation in and by international law issues and be ready for drafting legal papers concerning international law issues

You will study

- The concept, system, function of international law. Correlation of international law, foreign policy and diplomacy, domestic law.
- The evolution of international law. Norms of international law and its peculiarities. The subject of regulation. The basic principles of international law are their essence and content. The UN Charter and principles of international law
- States are the principal subjects of international law. Sovereignty, immunity and internal competence of a state

After this course you will

- be able to understand the logic of global processes and the development of the world political system of international relations in their historical, economic and legal context
- have the knowledge of the legal foundations of international interaction, understand and be able to analyze their impact on the foreign policy of different countries
- understand the foundations of human rights issues in international relations and the world practice of protecting human rights

5 vocational subject

Cultural diplomacy in contemporary world

2 ECTS

72 academic hours

The discipline starts on the 3 year of study

The main aim of the course is to make students acquainted with cultural diplomacy as an instrument of foreign cultural policy, its aims, objectives and sources, the experience of cultural diplomacy implementation

You will study

- Foreign cultural policy as an important component of a country's international activities. The main tasks of cultural diplomacy
- Organization and functions of the cultural service. Governmental structures in the sphere of cultural diplomacy. NGOs and public funds, patronage
- Leading directions of cultural diplomacy of the Russian Federation. Support of Russian compatriots. Strengthening the position of the Russian language and literature
- Humanitarian cooperation in specific areas and geopolitical priorities of foreign cultural policy

After this course you will

- be able to use the mechanisms of multilateral diplomacy for integration and solving task
- analyze the main directions of the foreign policy of different countries and their cultural interaction
- be able to navigate in multilateral mechanisms and the integration of diplomacy
